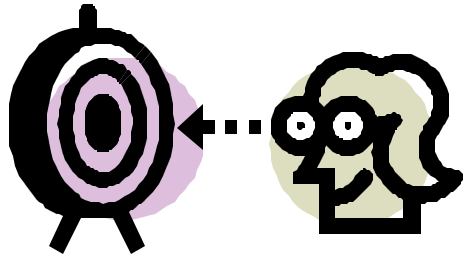


# Tuesday **FOCUS** Starts January 12



A five-week Tuesday evening study series, *Tuesday FOCUS*, will be offered for adults beginning January 12 through February 9. At *Tuesday FOCUS (First Opportunities for Christian Understanding and Study)*, participants will have the opportunity to choose from four courses:

- ***Do You Think Like Jesus?*** Whether or not we realize it, we all have a worldview... certain presuppositions and biases that affect the way we view all of life and reality. A 2003 Barna Research Group study revealed that only 9 percent of professing Christians actually have a biblical worldview. This study/discussion led by Fred Coates will focus on what constitutes a biblical worldview.
- ***Jesus' Design for Life: A Study of the Sermon on the Mount.*** How does Jesus want us to live as his disciples? In the Sermon on the Mount, he describes in detail how we are to think, act, and obey, and our need for grace and forgiveness as we do so. Clay Brown will guide us through this study of Matthew 5-7.
- ***Jesus through Middle Eastern Eyes.*** Despite what most movies tell us, Jesus wasn't British, Nordic, or American. He was a Middle Eastern Jewish man living 2000 years ago. Yet most of the time, we look at Jesus and the Bible through our own lens of contemporary western culture. How much are we missing? What are we seeing differently? This course by Tyler Domske will look at the four gospels with this in mind.
- ***Running the Rapids: Guiding Your Kids Through the Turbulent Waters of Adolescence.*** Christian psychologist Kevin Leman presents practical insights about raising adolescents in a DVD series, with class discussion led by Ellen Auten. Sessions include acceptable and unacceptable behavior, the importance of home, tough questions from teenagers, practical guidelines for survival, along with many other relevant and thought-provoking lessons. This course is an excellent study for parents and grandparents of teenagers, and for those who will be there in a few short years.

Light refreshments will be served in the fellowship hall from 6:30-7:00, with classes following from 7:00-8:30 p.m. Sign-ups will begin this Sunday in the parlor. Child care will be provided, with advance reservations essential. Note child care needs on the sign-up forms.
